To follow trends in Turkish Public Opinion regarding Turkish Foreign Policy.

1000 interviews; 18 years and older; 26 provinces

Samples: 95% confidence interval $\pm 3,0$ margin of error

Quantitative Method

CAPI (Computer-assisted personal interviewing) based on prepared survey question form.

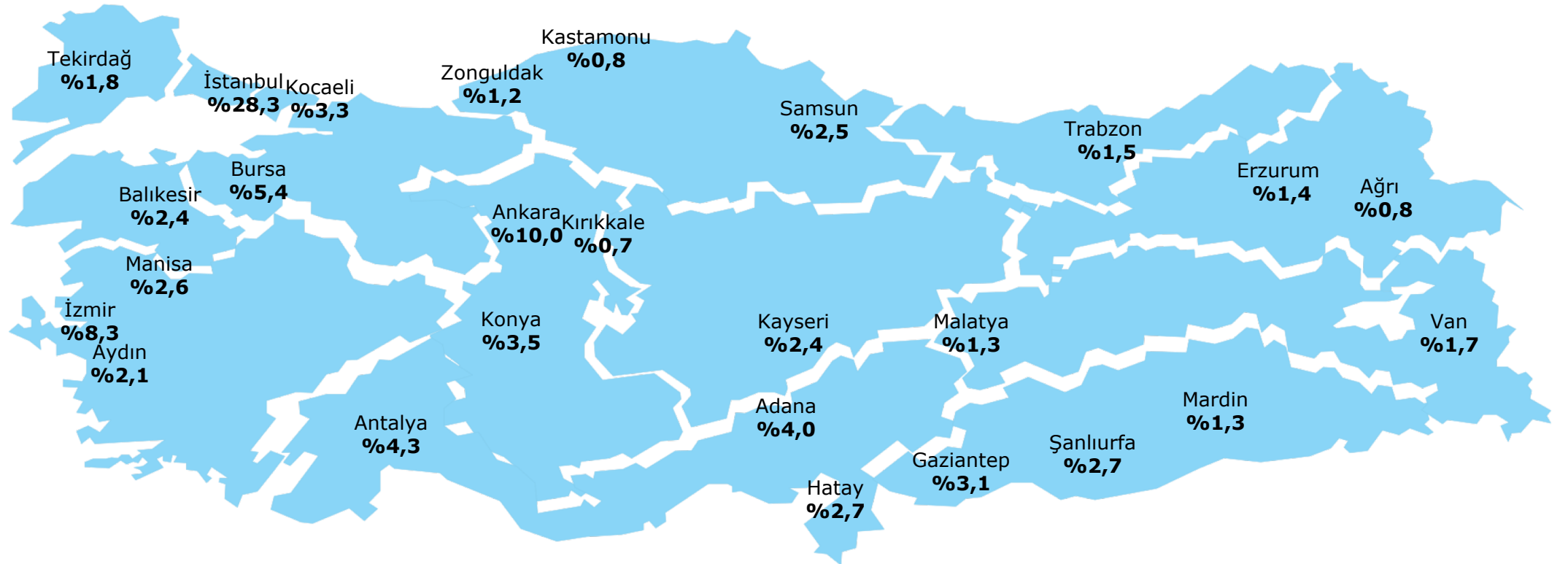

Explanation of the Terminology

PDT

Indicates the sum of positive values such as “definitely agree” and “agree”.

NDT

Indicates the sum of negative values such as “definitely disagree” and “disagree”.

Net Score

Indicates the difference between the Sum of Positive Values and Sum of Negative Values.

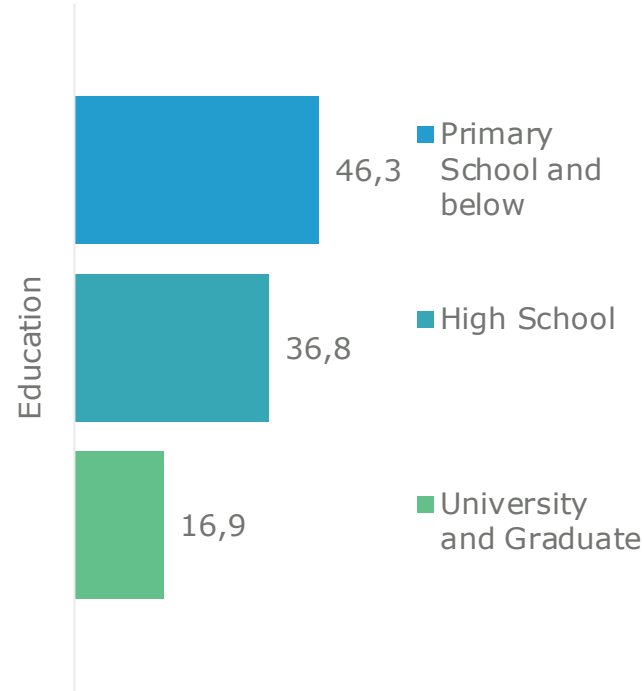


Socio-Economic Status

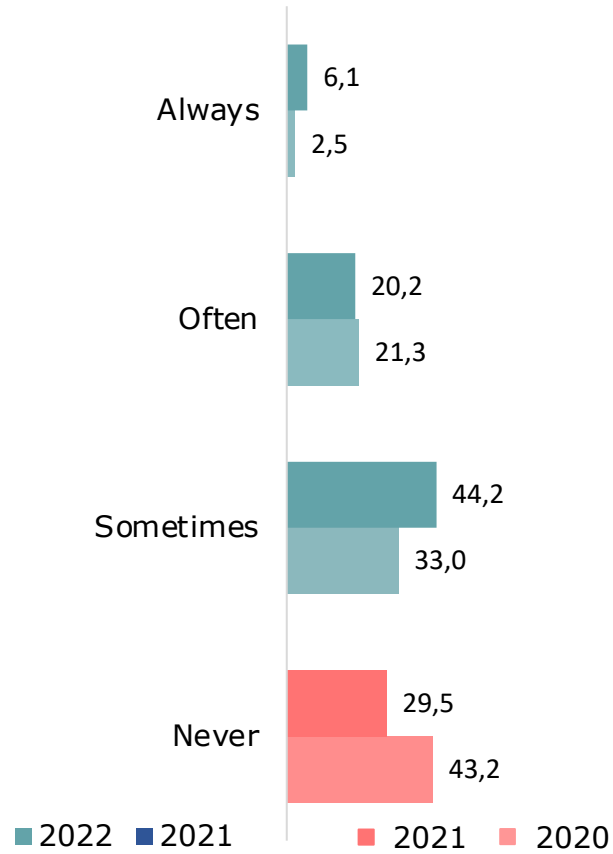

Frequency of Talking Politics

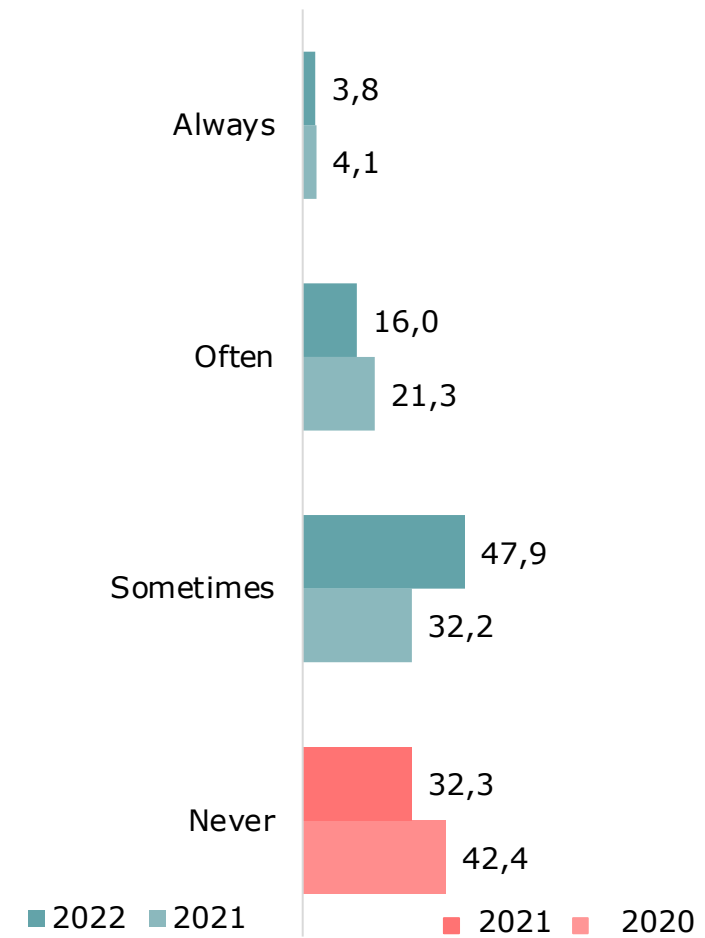
How often do you talk politics when you get together with your friends?

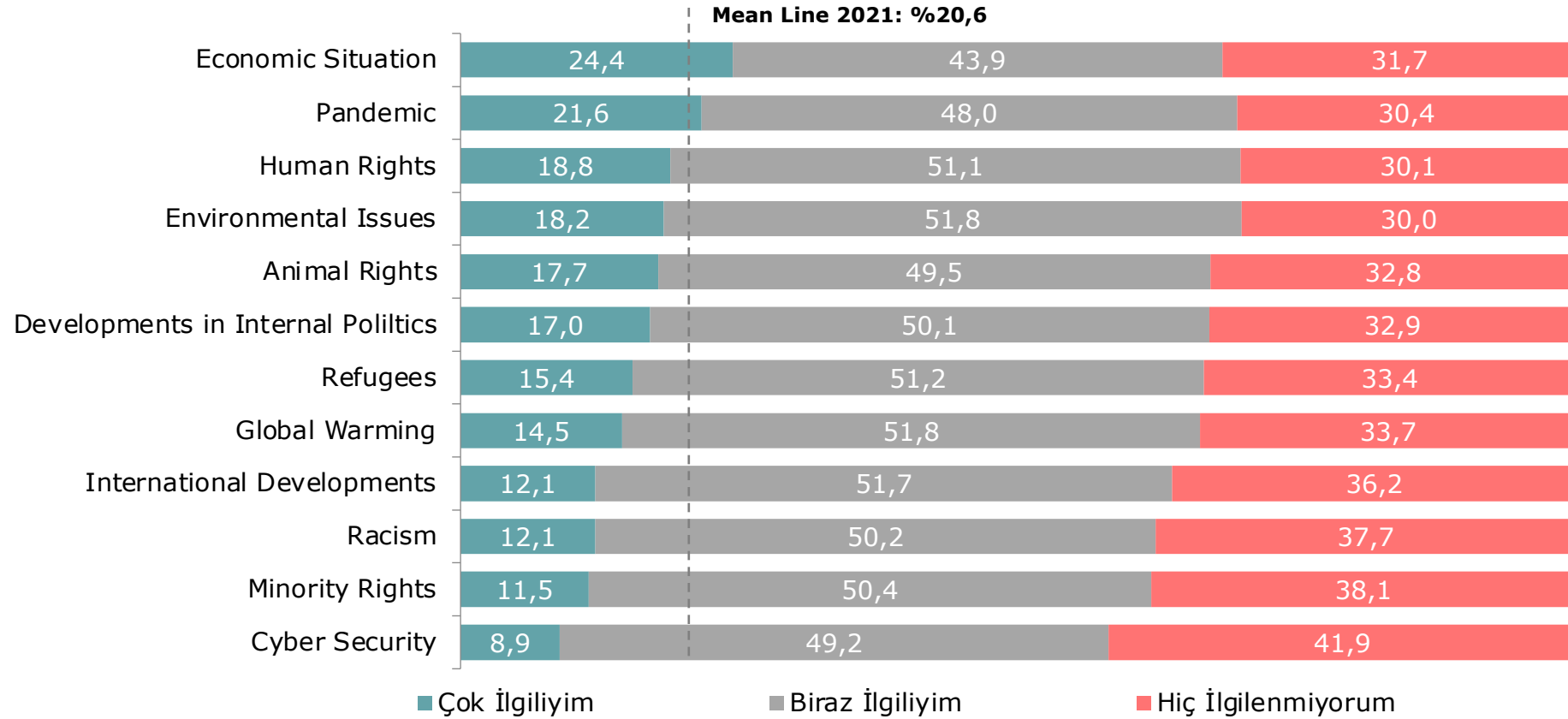
Frequency of Talking about Foreign Policy Issues

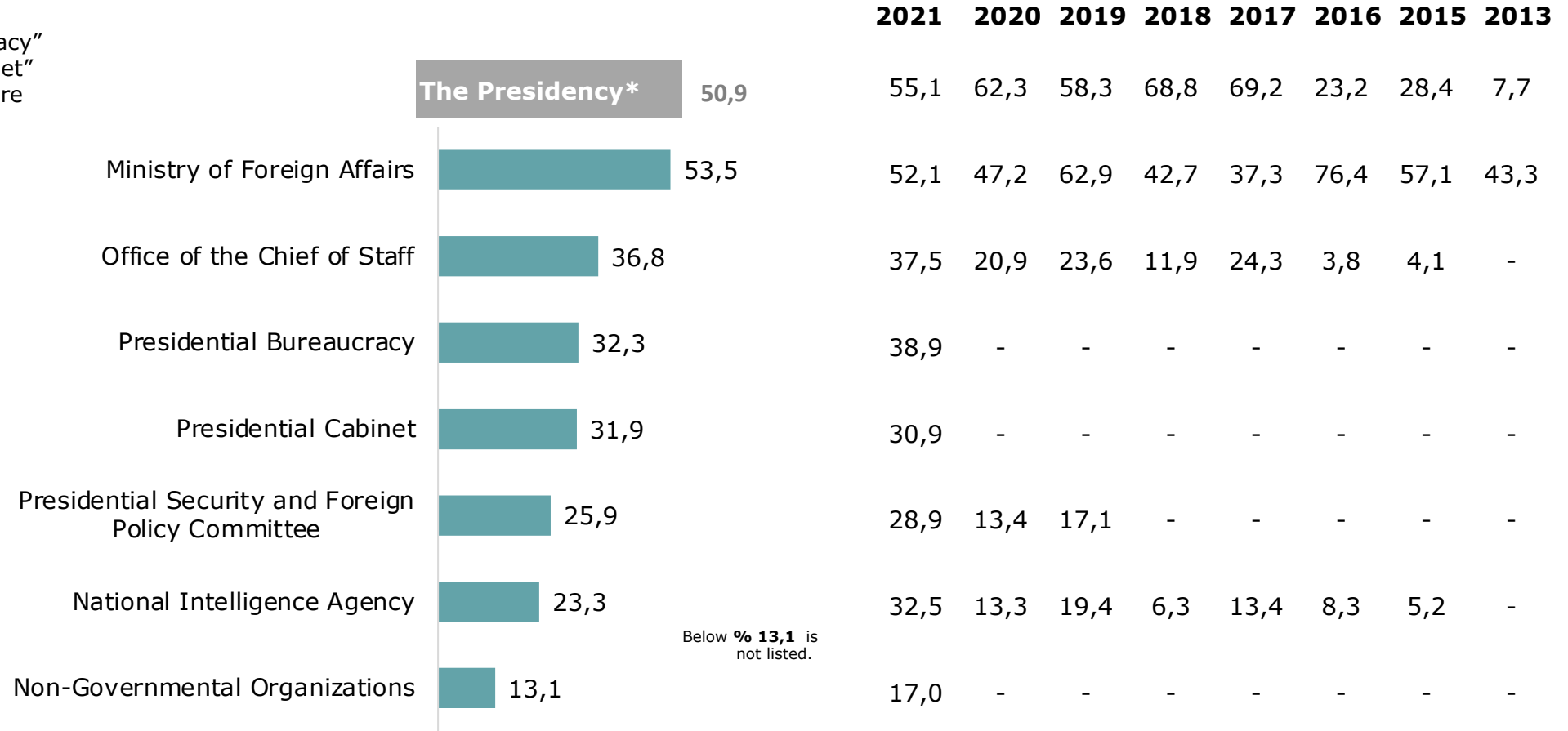

In your opinion, what should be the main duties of the Ambassadors of the Republic of Turkey in the countries they are appointed to?



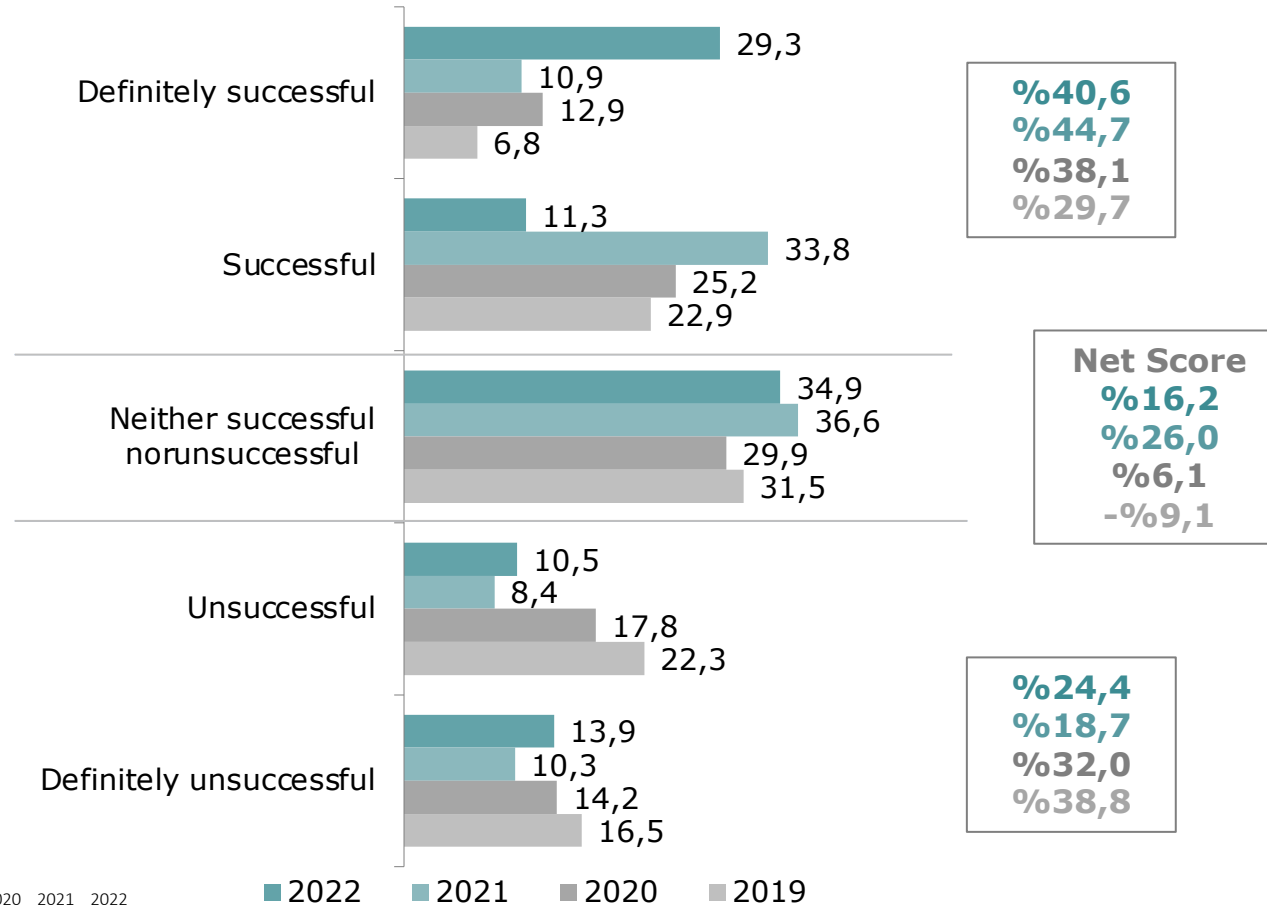

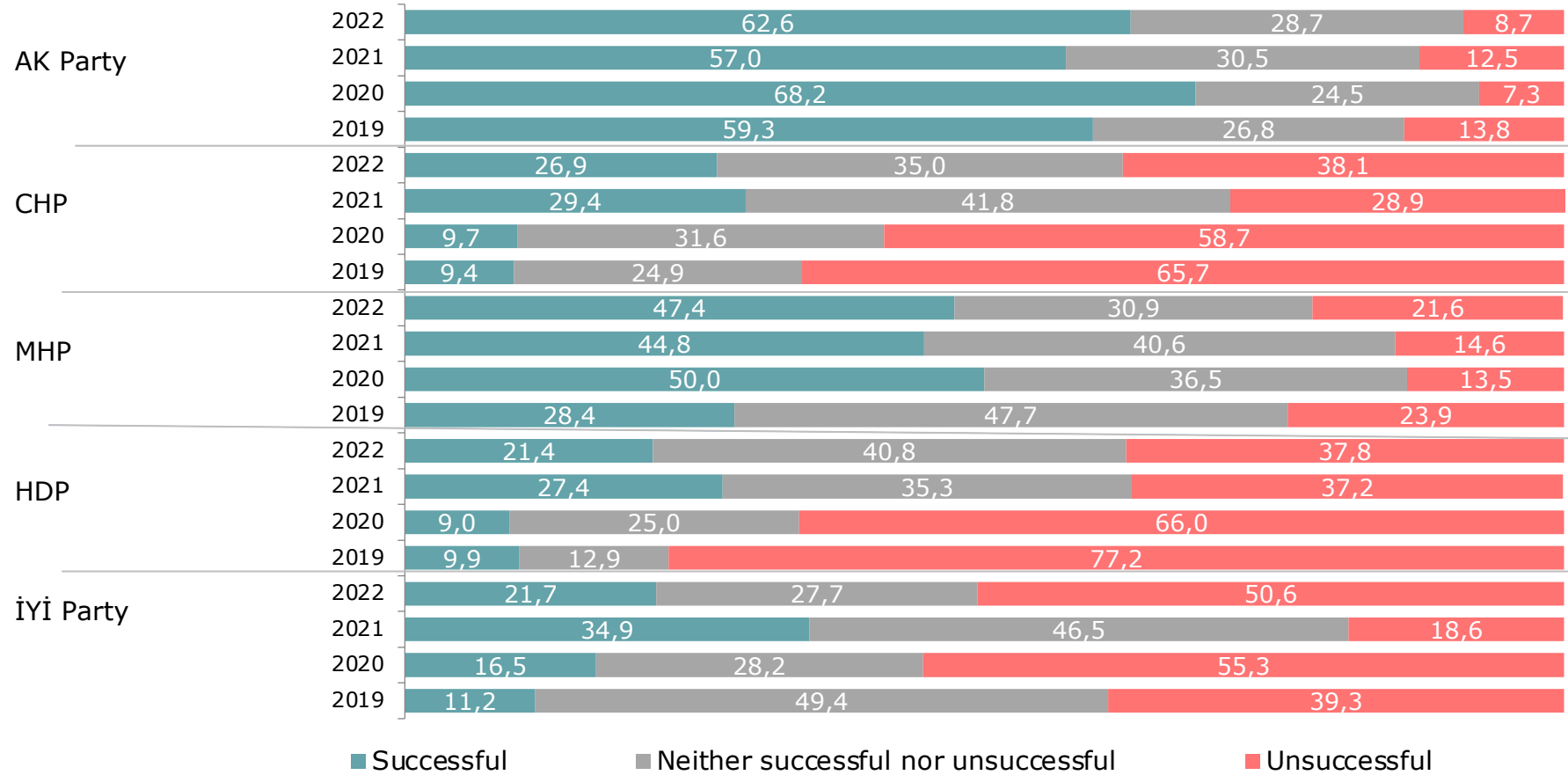

To what extent do you consider the Presidential Cabinet's foreign policy successful?



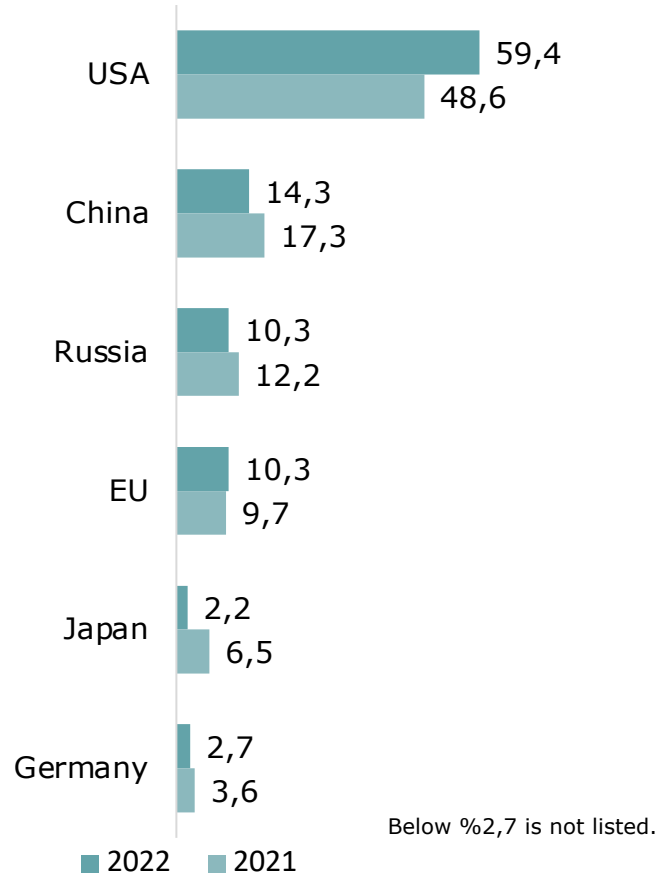

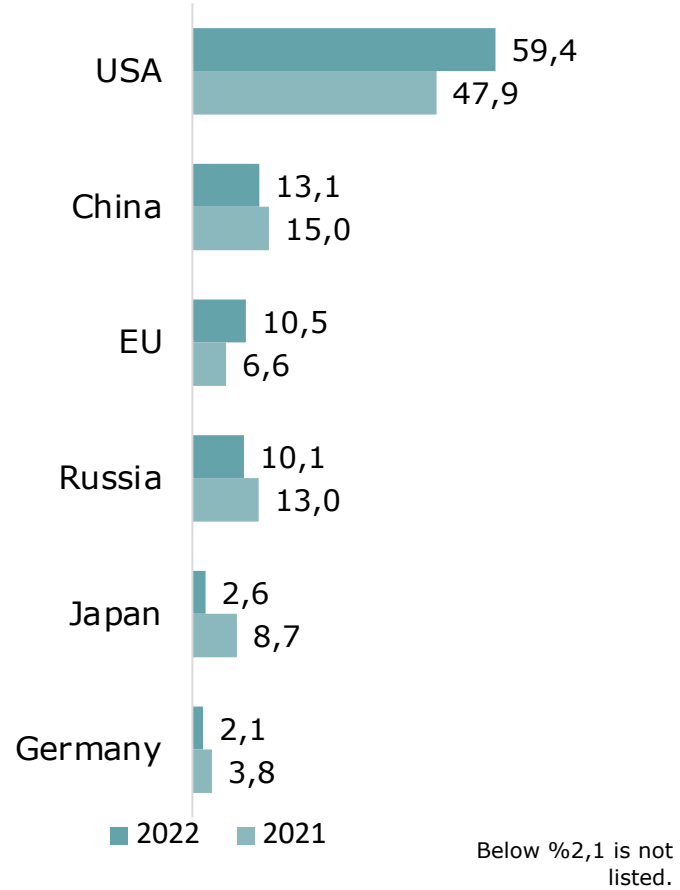

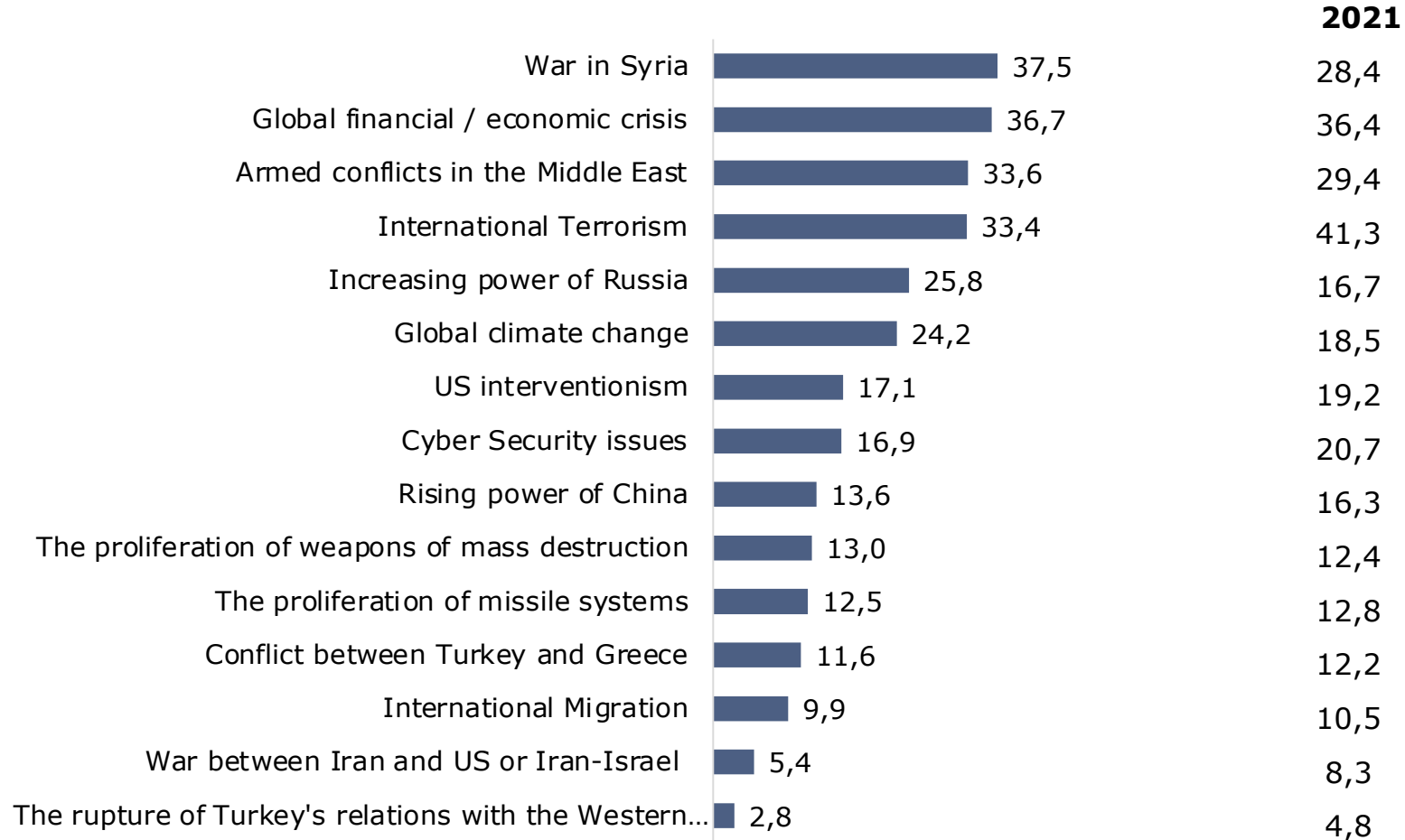
Most Important Foreign Policy Issue Turkey Will Face in the Next 10 Years?

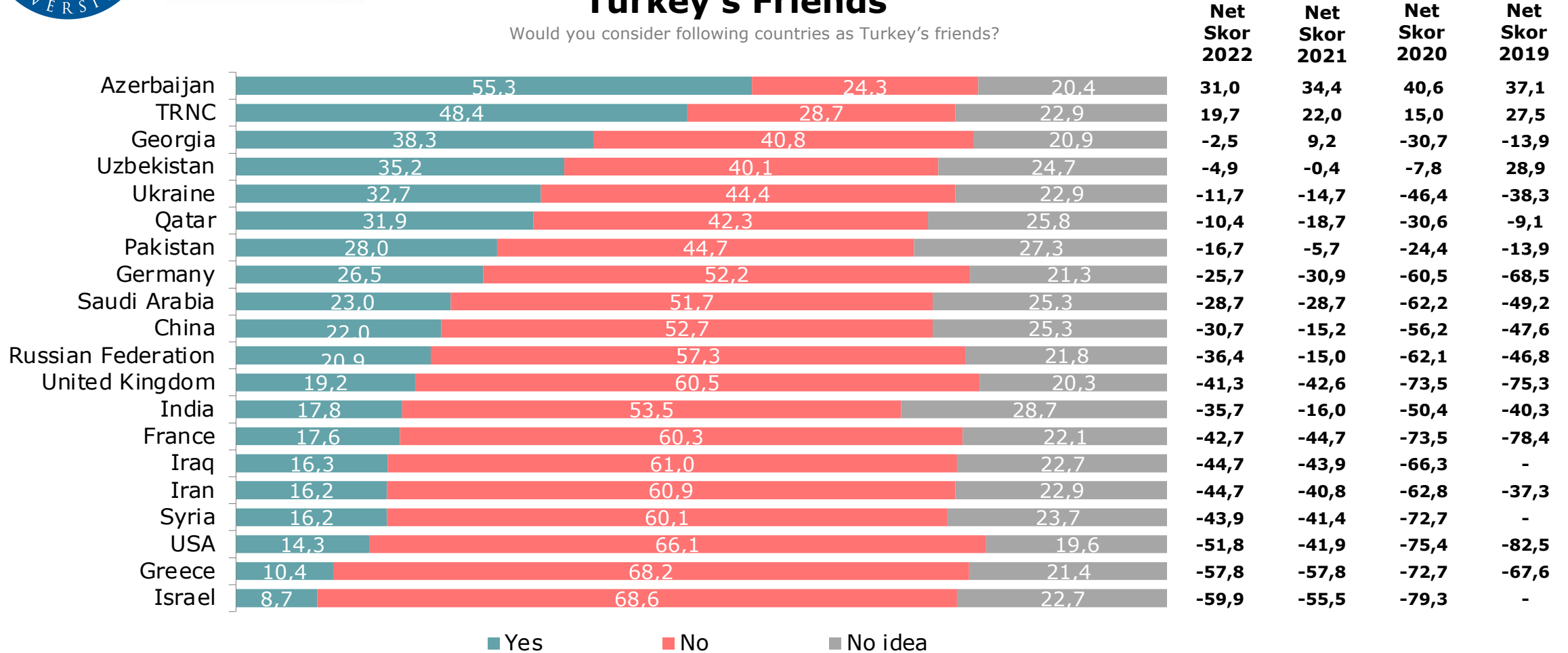

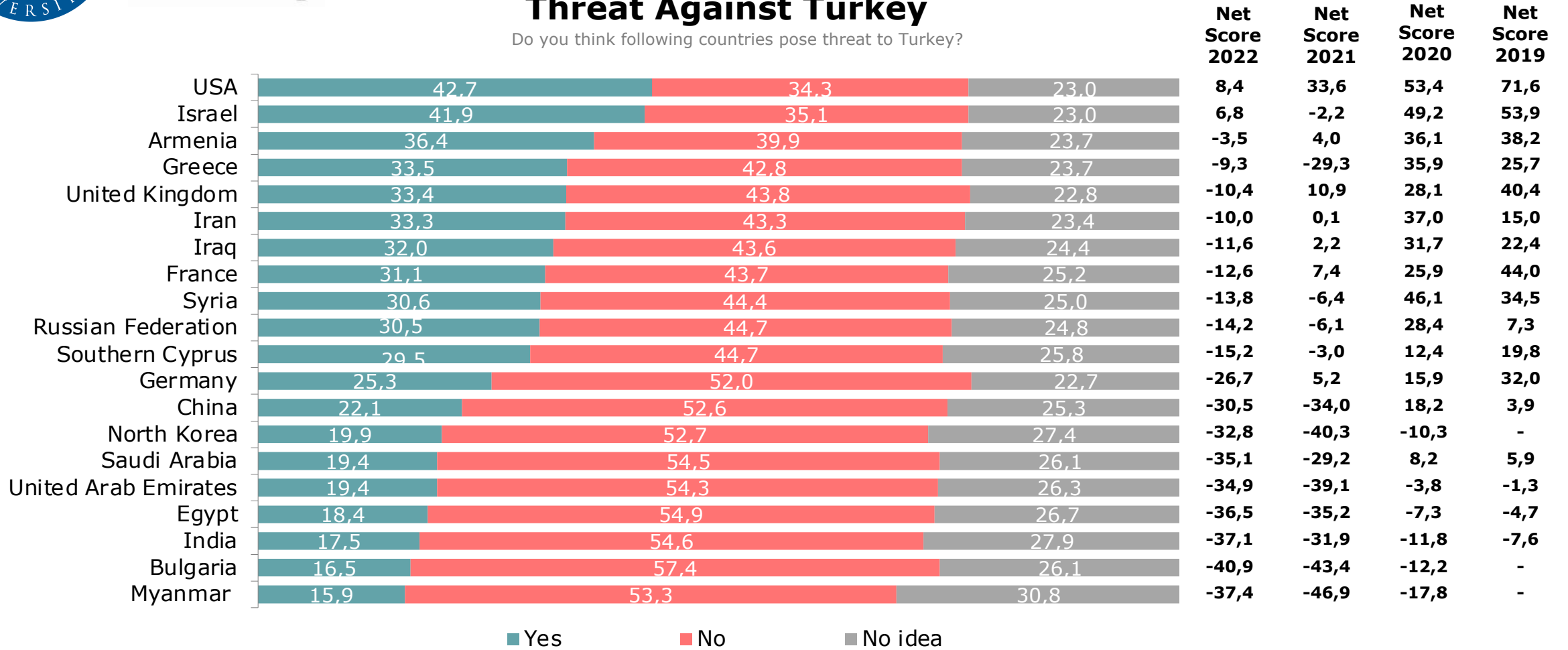

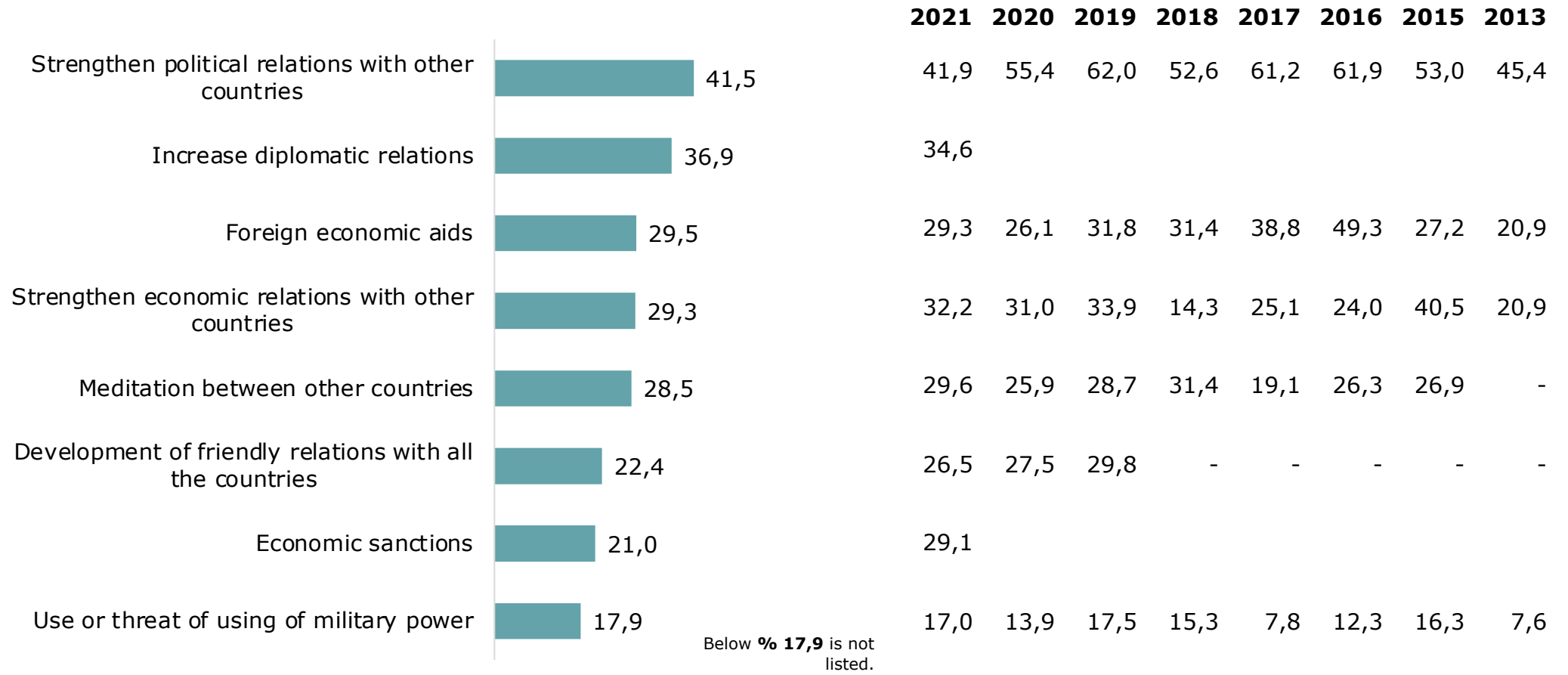

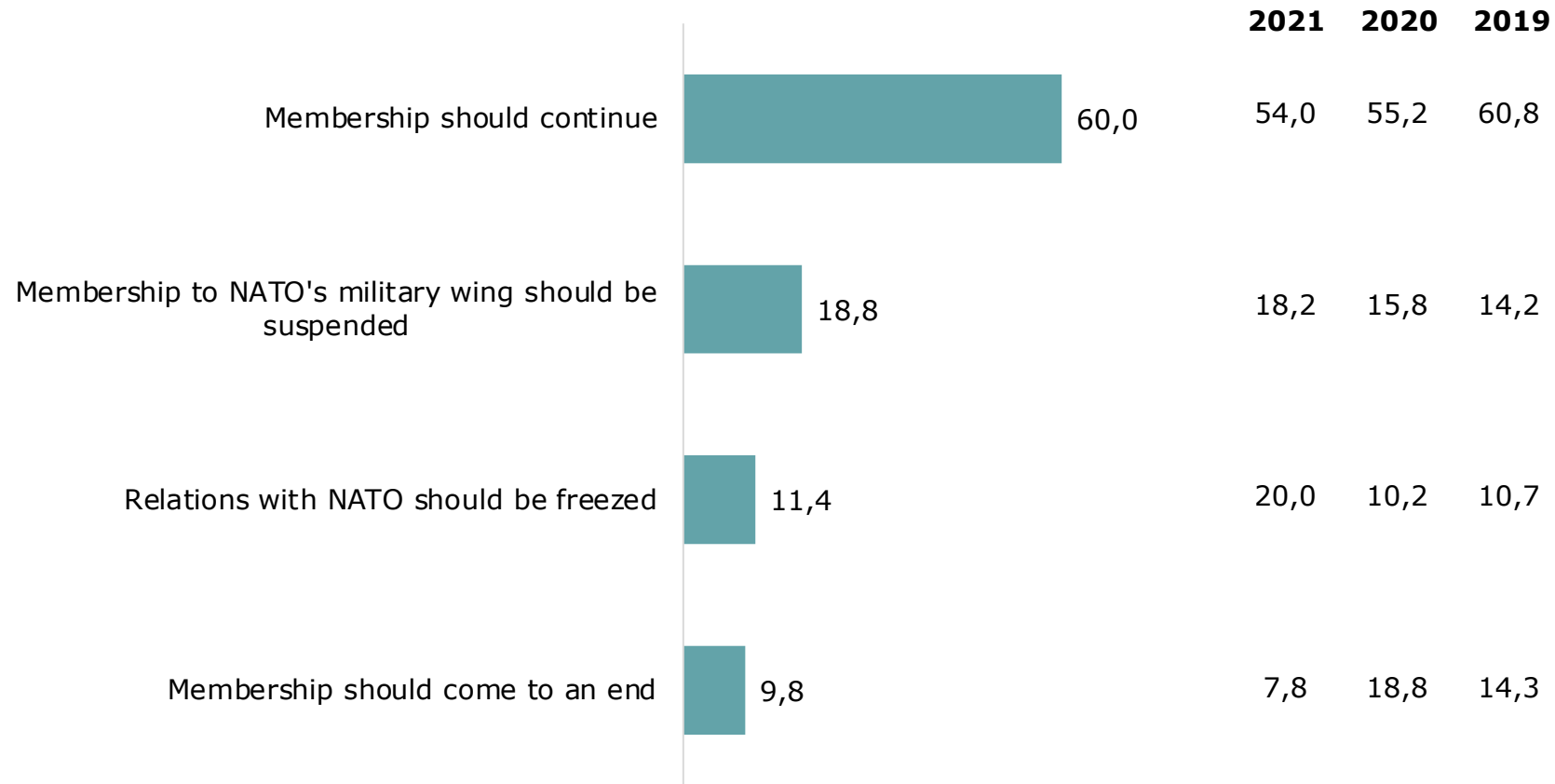

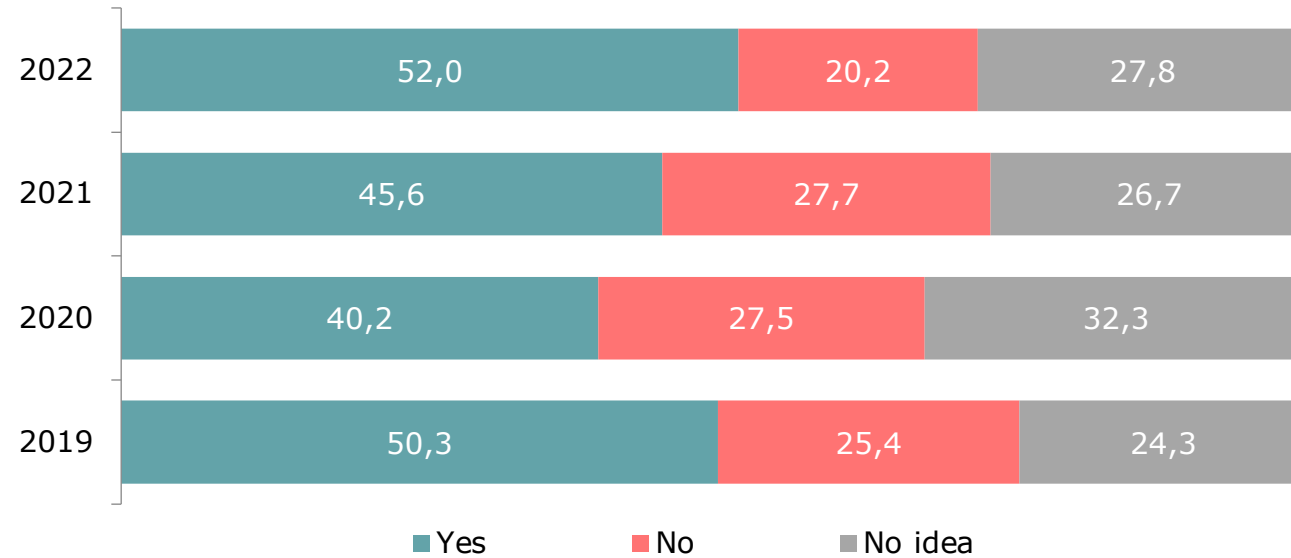

Do you think being member of NATO is beneficial to Turkey?



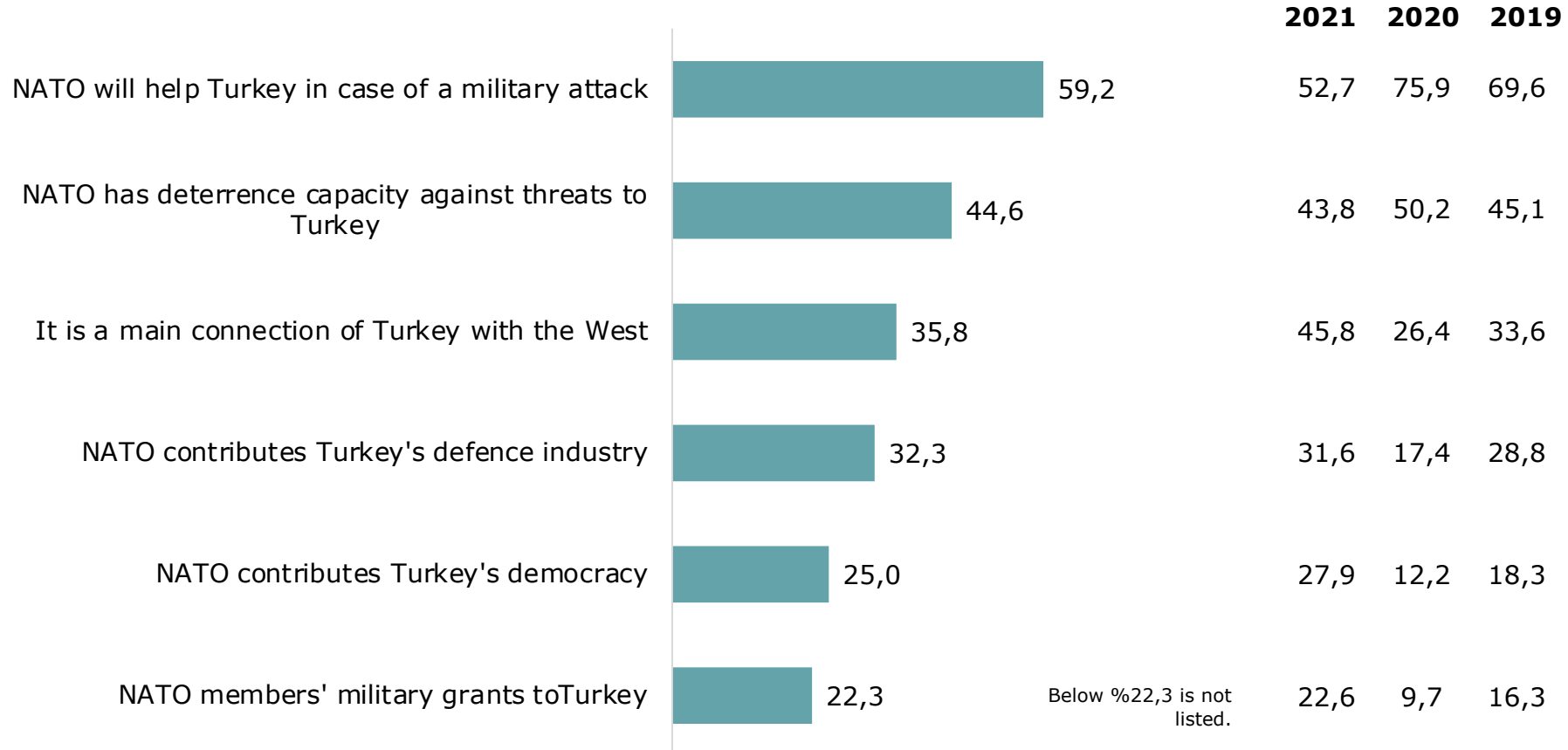

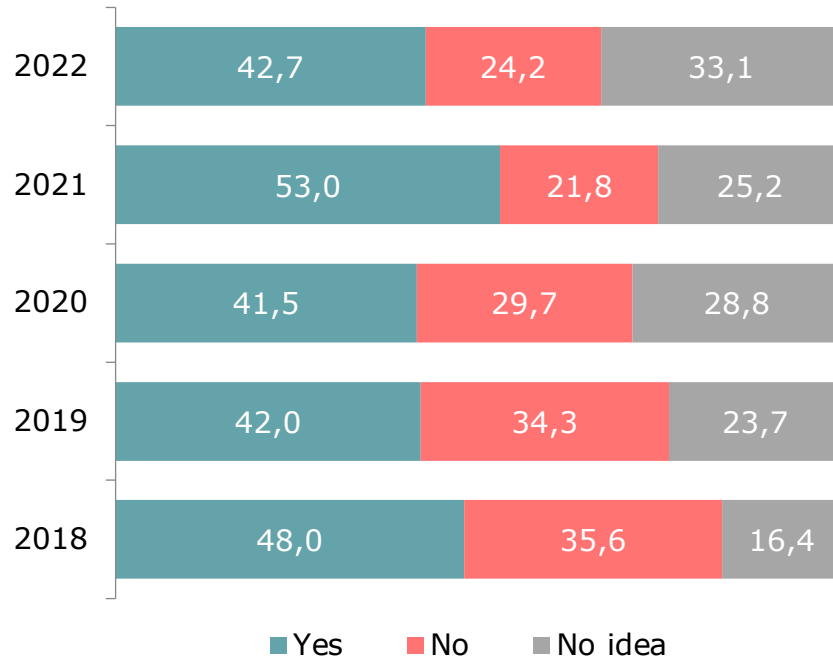

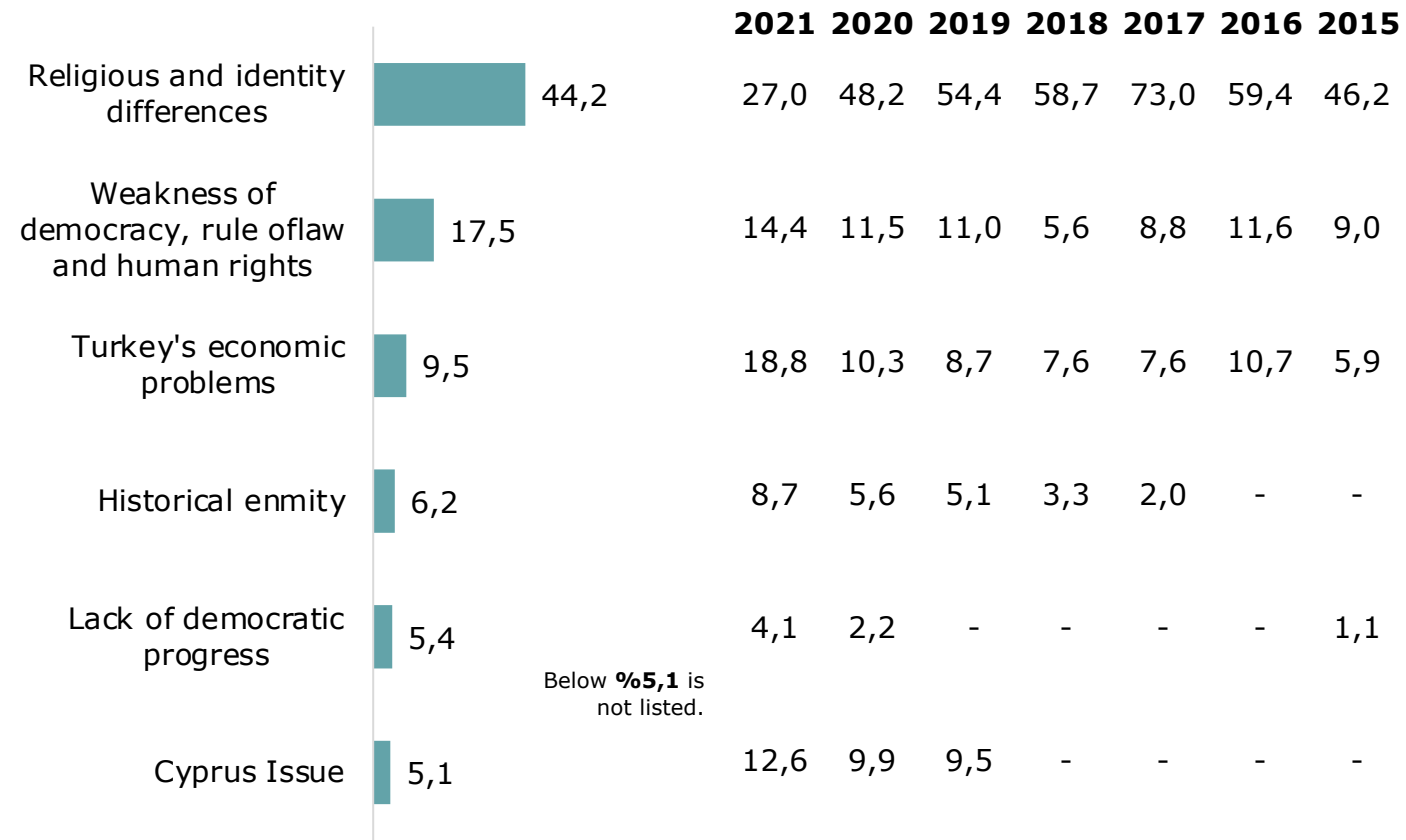
