OBJECTIVE

To follow trends in Turkish Publich Opinion regarding Turkish Foreign Policy.

SAMPLE

Population:

1000 interviews; 18 years and older; 26 provinces

Samples: 95% confidence interval ±3,0 margin of error

METHODOLOGY

Quantitative Method

CAPI (Computerassisted personal interviewing) based on prepared survey question form.








Which Party did you vote in 24 June 2018 General Elections?



How would you define your political views?






Frequency of talking politics with Friends





Who are the most influential person(s) in foreign policy making in Turkey?










Evaluation of the Presidential Cabinet's Foreign Policy

To what extent do you consider the presidential cabinet's foreign policy successful?




Do you think that Turkey's EU membership is being blocked?


